MATHEMATICS

- ❖ Daily opportunities to count how many people are at school.
- ❖ Answering yes and no questions.
- ❖ Days of the week song and rhymes.
- ❖ Counting collections using different objects.
- ❖ Rote counting.
- ❖ Opportunities to recognise numbers - single and double digits.
- ❖ Matching pictures to objects.
- ❖ Exploring various 2D and 3D shapes.
- ❖ Ordering objects according to size.
- ❖ Colour recognition.

ENGLISH

- ❖ Whole class Fairy tale focus. We will be reading, watching and completing various activities based on Goldilocks and the Three Bears, The Three Little Pigs, Jack and the Beanstalk, The Gingerbread Man and The Little Red Hen.
- ❖ Daily exposure to various Nursery Rhymes.

- ❖ Daily opportunities for name writing and recognition.
- ❖ Letter formation.
- ❖ Pre-writing patterns using Peggy Lego prompts.
- ❖ Single letter sounds.
- ❖ Exposure to sight words and CVC words.
- ❖ Speaking and listening - sharing news, sharing likes and dislikes, listening to others and stories.

LIFE SKILLS

- ❖ Weekly cooking sessions every Friday.
- ❖ Gross motor development - stepping stones, trampoline, walkers, swing, sand pit play, balloon batting, target throwing, ball play, balance boards etc.
- ❖ Fine motor development - painting, play dough, sensory play trays, bubble popping, cutting, gluing, peg play, puzzles, blocks etc.
- ❖ Learning body parts.
- ❖ Circle of Trust Program.

INDIVIDUAL EDUCATION PLANS

- ❖ Individual work tubs focusing on each child's individual goals set out in IEP.
- ❖ Incorporation of each child's communication device into all aspects of teaching and learning.
