COGNITIVE/LANGUAGE

- Recall events in sequence
- Roleplay writing some numbers and letters
- Engage in dramatic play, taking on pretend character roles
- Count by rote 1-5
- Touch objects to count (counts 1-5 things)
- Recount a recent story
- Follow simple rules
- Use language to ask and answer simple questions, greet people, recall personal experiences, negotiate, tell stories, express feelings, play, communicate information and solve problems.
